



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT between

FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE AND FOREST RESOURCE, SOUPHANOUVONG UNIVERSITY (Lao People's Democratic Republic)

and

FACULTY OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION, MAEJO UNIVERSITY (Kingdom of Thailand)

1. OBJECTIVE:

The Faculty of Agriculture and Forest Resource, Souphanouvong University(SU), Lao P.D.R. and the Faculty of Agricultural Production, Maejo University (MJU), Thailand hereby agree to enhance and formalize the existing relations between the two parties with a focus on strengthening exchange in education, academics, student activities, research and culture.

2. PRINCIPLE OF AGREEMENT: 2

Both parties agree to closely cooperate and coordinate with each other for the equal and mutual benefit of both educational institutions and for the continuous development of higher education in the region.

3. MAIN ACTIVITIES:

The two parties will encourage following main activities

- a) Exchange of students, scholars and faculties (professors, lecturers, administrators or researchers);
- b) Collaboration on staff development programs;
- c) Exchange of academic information and materials of mutual interest;
- d) Organization of joint research programs;
- e) Other academic exchanges as agreed upon by both parties;
- f) Promotion of the partnership via website, newspapers and other media;

The detailed terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Memorandum of Agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in written form by both parties prior to the initiation of the respective activity. Each institution shall designate a liaison officer to coordinate the specific activities agreed upon.

4. Budget:

The budget for implementing these activities will be discussed and agreed by both parties for each activity.

5. EFFECTIVENESS and DURATION of AGREEMENT:

This agreement shall be effective upon signature by both parties. Any additions or changes need a mutual agreement in written form by both institutions. This memorandum of agreement shall be binding for four (4) years and can be renewed for a further period upon agreement by both
